



Removal

NOTE: Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

All Vehicles

- 1. Remove underhood grille opening panel top shroud
 - 1. Remove the screws and position the air intake duct aside.
 - 2. Remove the push pins.
 - 3. Release the tabs and remove the radiator sight shield.





2. Remove the bolts. *Torque*: 44 lb.in (5 Nm)



3. Remove the screws and the radiator upper shield. *Torque*: 42 lb.in (4.8 Nm)





4. Using an appropriate sized flat-blade screwdriver release the locking tabs from front bumper. Use the General Equipment: Flat Headed Screw Driver

Extreme cold weather will cause breakage. A hair dryer can be used to localize warmth before flexing release tabs.
